FuturArc Forum 2008 will enable 4,000 architects, developers, engineers and students of these professions to learn more about green building and sustainable design first-hand from leading architects, engineers and academics. The nine conferences, each designed as an exceptional day of learning and information exchange, will be held in Jakarta, Singapore, Manila, Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok, Ho Chi Minh City, Sydney, Hong Kong and Shanghai between February and April 2008. Besides speeches by pioneers in green building, each conference will feature a presentation of awards for the FuturArc Prize 2008 competition and the release of a nine-country survey on green building.



**Kazuo Iwamura**, M.E., is a Professor in the Faculty of Environment and Information Studies at the Musashi Institute of Technology in Yokohama Japan and CEO of IWAMURA Atelier Co., Ltd. He is also Chair of ARCASE's Committee for Green & Sustainable Architecture, UIA Councilor of Region IV (Asia + Oceania), Director of the UIA Work Programme Architecture for a Sustainable Future and a member of the board of the World Green Building Council.



**Deo Prasad**, PhD, is Professor in the field of sustainable built environments and head of the sustainable development Masters program at UNSW in Sydney. Deo has published in excess of 150 publications on sustainable built environments including five books. He was awarded the 2006 National Award for contribution to research and design in sustainable buildings by the Royal Australian Institute of Architects and has also won the 2004 NSW individual GreenGlobe Award for leadership in renewable energy. Deo has worked on award winning projects, been part of the expert team at the Sydney Green Olympics and many milestone projects. He is Chair of the Standards Australia committee on Energy in buildings, member of Canadian Solar Buildings Network Board, UNEP special committee on urbanisation in Asia pacific.



**Martin Reuter**, was born in Koblenz in 1972. He studied architecture at RWTH Technical University Aachen from 1992-1998. Since 1998 Martin works for Ingen-hoven Architects. Martin has worked on design, planning and administration on a variety of projects, including commercial, residential and retail. As project partner he is engaged in both, leading design competitions and realising projects through to completion. His focus is on overseas projects.



**Ulf Meyer**, a trained architect, prominent author and lecturer in the field of architecture and urban design based in Berlin. He has lectured at universities and cultural centres in Europe, the USA and Canada as well as Japan, China and Taiwan. He has published over 700 articles in newspapers and magazines as well as several well-known books on urban design and architecture.
