## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Is my project eligible to be certified under the Green Star – Multi Unit Residential v1 rating tool?

To find out whether your project is eligible to be certified under Green Star – Multi Unit Residential v1, please refer to the Green Star Eligibility document, available from the [GBCA website](#). ### When and how can I register my project to be certified under Green Star – Multi Unit Residential v1?

Registrations for projects to be certified under Green Star – Multi Unit Residential v1 are now open. To register a project, please submit a completed registration form to the GBCA. Registration forms are available from our [website](#).

### How much does it cost to register my project to be rated under Green Star – Multi Unit Residential v1?

Registration fees vary according to the size of developments. Registration fees range between \$5,000 and \$30,000 depending on the project. For more information, visit the [Assessment Fee](#) section of our website.
