Credit Criteria

Up to two points are awarded where it is demonstrated that a percentage of work settings have a direct line of sight through vision glazing, either externally or to an adequately sized and naturally lit internal atrium, as follows:

- 1 point = 60% of work settings;
- 2 points = 90% of work settings.

The distance to the nearest vision glazing is to be no more than eight metres.

Documents Provided

✓	Calculations that show that the NLA that is within eight metres of vision glazing, as a fraction of the total number of work settings (Shown in discussion below)
✓	As-built drawings that show the floor layout, the location of internal walls and partitions and their heights and materials, sight lines and the area which meets the Credit Criteria. Sight lines must take into account the thickness of external wall

Discussion

Below are calculations that show that the NLA that is within eight metres of vision glazing, as a fraction of the total NLA:
