



Invitation to attend a guided Site Tour of the Kinley site – a 6 Star Green Star Community

All GBCA VIC delegates are invited to attend a guided site tour of the historic Kinley site in Lilydale, in Melbourne's outer east on Wednesday 1st June. Max Shifman, Intrapac Property's Chief Operating Officer and guest speaker at the 2022 Green Building Day, will host tours of this historical site (now known as Kinley) which operated as the Cave Hill Limestone Quarry for 137 years.

Once owned by David Mitchell, this 163ha site benefits from a rich history with limestone from the site used in many of Melbourne's earliest buildings and in the very-familiar Lilydale Toppings. Some of the quarry's early structures and equipment including kilns, silos and farm buildings remain standing and will be transformed into community facilities as part of this new 6 star Green Star Communities development.

The area of the former Cave Hill quarry makes up approximately 15% of the land at Kinley and is being progressively filled until it seamlessly blends back into the surrounding land. The filling commenced in late 2017 and is anticipated to be completed in 2024, after which it will undergo rigorous monitoring prior to development to deliver the comprehensive development plan which underpins the Kinley Vision. www.kinley.com.au
