BREAKFAST WITH THE STARS 6 STARS FOR SUSTAINABLE SHOPPING

As Green Star extends to new industry sectors, Mirvac's Orion Shopping Centre has become a shining example of the new generation of green developments and a leader in sustainable design.

Orion Springfield is the first shopping centre in Australia to achieve a 6 Star Green Star – Shopping Centre PILOT rating, establishing itself as a world leader and paving the way for aspiring shopping centre projects around the country.

This seminar will give you an insight into how the team of Orion Springfield has worked with a PILOT rating tool to design and construct a green shopping centre that will influence other projects to take the next step within the Green Star rating system. After a presentation on the project, a panel will be convened to allow for audience questions and discussion.

ORION SPRINGFIELD

Mirvac have gone above and beyond Green Star to create a shopping centre that will provide better quality of service to its tenants and customers. Orion combines the best of a traditional town square – with its main street, plazas and parks – and integrates this with a carefully planned retail environment unlike any other in Australia.

The design of Orion is atypical to the standard "shopping centre box" allowing Mirvac to showcase not only its ongoing dedication to sustainability in development but also an innovative design for customers' shopping centre experience.

Due to the design and operation of the malls, Orion achieved high daylight penetration into the malls without compromising the Thermal Comfort of the building, reaching a 2.5 Daylight Factor for 95% of the malls. The centre uses just over half the energy of a similar size shopping centre and its recycled water (A+ equivalent) supply to the cooling towers is a first in retail development in Australia.
