The Purchaser agrees to insure the goods as bailee and agent of the Contractor and the Purchaser agrees to maintain such insurance as current and pay all premiums when due in the name of the Contractor.

Property, title and ownership passes to the Purchaser on receipt by the Contractor of payment in full of all monies owing to the Contractor for all goods and/or services supplied by the Contractor.

I've left a message with you and thought I'd send through an email explaining my call.

I'm in the final throes of collecting Green Star documentation in order to submit for Round 1 very soon and I've identified a discrepancy in our documentation for Mat-1 Workstations and Mat-5 Tables. I've attached the the confirmation letter you sent through regarding the supply and install of Marina Workstations and Marina and QED Tables as well as our Green Star summary sheet on these products provided by Michael Pitcher. According to the summary sheet, all of the above products are warranted for 10 years + 1 day. However, according to clause L. in the letter you've provided, items are warranted for 5 years. Can you please supply either of the following:

A revised Green Star materials supply letter with a clause L. that includes a warranty for up to 10 years + 1 day from date of supply for all Marina Workstations, Marina Tables and QED Tables supplied, or
 A warranty for all Marina Workstations, Marina Tables and QED Tables supplied that clearly takes precedence over the warranty stated in your Green Star letter.

I have highlighted the Green Star summary sheets where the warranty is called out. Please note that to satisfy Green Star requirements, the warranty must guarantee the entire table or workstation and allow for repairs and/or replacement. Feel free to ring me if any of this is unclear.

An annual public report will be available of the ultimate fate of the materials and products returned under these agreements.

In order to maximize the efficient use of resources it is important that clients indicate their wish to enter into a Product Stewardship agreement in the pre-tender stage of purchasing.

The conditions will generally include:

- That the customer returns the products to our Tullamarine Plant;
- That the products are in their original state not changed or re-finished and resulting from normal wear and tear;
- A specified minimum quantity of items;

1. Product Stewardship

- 1.1 Schiavello will accept the return of Products at the end of their service life in order to recycle and re-use the Products on the following conditions:
- (i) a minimum number of 25 Products be returned per return;
- (ii) Schiavello will accept Products that are at the end of their service life or no more than 15 years has passed from the date of purchase of the Products, whichever is earlier;
- (iii) the Products are transported to Schiavello headquarters at Tullamarine, Victoria at GBCA's cost;
- (iv) the party wishing to enforce this clause is the original purchaser who acquired new Schiavello Products (the clause is non-transferable);




