In order for the credit to be awarded, please verify the actual carpet type used for the project (refer comments IEQ-11).

Compliance with Credit Criteria

In order to confirm the type of carpet specified and installed in Greenhouse, we have provided a for construction specification as well as a product stewardship policy for the product. The subcontractor installation letter has been provided again showing the carpet name.

Documents Provided

- [2] For construction floor finishes specification.
- [4] Product stewardship policy.
- [6] Subcontractor installation confirmation letter.
- [7] Round 1 Submission is provided in its entirety.

Discussion

We trust that as the specification, subcontractor installation confirmation letter, and product stewardship policy all state the name of the carpet, this should be sufficient to confirm that the carpet supplied is the same as the carpet tested. We note that the GECA certificate nominated InterfaceFLOR GlasBac carpet is contained in the Round 1 submission (on page 14 of this pdf).

Sample size:

- Tiles: 4 x tile size.

Edge strip: Submit a 300mm length of each type.

- Bonding adhesive.

2 PRODUCTS

2.1 MARKING

Identification

General: Deliver materials to the site and report to the site foreman for verification of compliance – including all relevant glues and sealants - in the manufacturer's original sealed containers legibly marked to show the following:

- Manufacturer's identification.
- Product brand name.
- Product type.
- Dimensions and quantity.
- Product reference code and batch number.
- Date of manufacture.
- Material composition and characteristics such as volatility, flash point, light fastness, colour and pattern.
- Handling and installation instructions.

2.2 CARPET

Tolerances

Standard: To AS 1385.

Batching

General: Carpet laid in a single area and of a single specified type, quality, colour and design, must come from one manufacturing batch and dye lot.

Insect resistance

Insecticide: Provide carpets and underlays composed entirely of materials either inherently resistant to insect attack, or treated against insect attack, including by moth and carpet beetle, by application of insecticide to the yarn during the dyeing or scouring process.

2.3 CARPET TILES

Carpet tiles

Type: 'Non-stick', non-curling tiles capable of being taken up without damage and then relaid in different positions.

Marking: On the back, showing recommended direction of laying.

Carpet tile tolerances:

- Edge dimensions: ± 2 mm.
- Squareness: Maximum difference of 2 mm between lengths of diagonals.

2.4 ADHESIVES AND TAPES

Standard

General: To AS/NZS 2455.1.

Adhesives

General: Compatible with the floor covering material, and suitable for bonding it to the subfloor. Refer Volatile Organic Compound requirements.

3 EXECUTION

3.1 SUBSTRATE

Substrates

General: Ensure substrates conform to the Substrate tolerance table and are as follows:

- To AS/NZS 2455.1 or AS/NZS 2455.2, as appropriate.
- Clean and free of any deposit or finish which may impair adhesion or location and functioning of movement joints.

Substrate tolerance table

Concrete substrate correction: Remove projections and fill voids and hollows with a levelling compound compatible with the adhesive.

- Concrete: The moisture content of the concrete has been tested to AS/NZS 2455.1 Appendix B and values obtained as follows:
 - . ≤ 5.5% when tested by the electrical resistance method.
 - . ≤ 70% when tested by the surface hygrometer test.

WARRANTY - ReEntry Program

INTERFACE AUST. HOLDINGS PTY LTD (INTERFACE)

Interface is committed to delivering sustainable solutions to the supply and installation of modular carpet. The ReEntry program aims to bring the most sustainable and cost effective solution to keep vinyl backed carpet tile products out of the landfill, while reducing the impact on the environment. Using new technology, the vinyl backings are separated from the nylon fibres of used Interface GlasBac® & GlasBac® RE modules and any of our competitors vinyl backed carpet tiles (subject to minimum quality standards). The vinyl is then ground and pulverized and recycled to make backing for new GlasBac® RE carpet tile while the nylon is redirected for other uses.

In this Warranty, the bolded terms shall have the meanings set out in the Schedule.

This Warranty is for the benefit of the **Owner** and for any subsequent owner of the **Property** during the **Term** and all references to the **Owner** shall be deemed to include reference to such subsequent owner.

Subject to the terms and conditions set out below, Interface warrants that during the **Term**, it will reclaim the **Prescribed Amount** of **Carpet Tile** located at the **Property** for the **Fee** and will reprocess the **Carpet Tile** into backing materials for new GlasBac® RE modules:

- 1. The **Owner** shall be responsible for and meet all charges in respect of:
 - (a) The uptake of the Carpet Tile and all associated furniture relocation and computer relocation;
 - (b) Sorting the Carpet Tile;
 - (c) Packing the Carpet Tile on pallets and movement of the Carpet Tile to the loading dock.
- 2. To exercise your rights under this Warranty, the **Owner** must:
 - (a) contact Interface at least 14 days prior to the date required for reclamation of the Carpet Tile:
 - (b) remove the **Carpet Tile**, pack the **Carpet Tile** onto pallets and deliver to the loading dock located on or near the **Property**; and
 - (c) pay the **Fee** to Interface [in accordance with Interface's usual payment terms].
- 3. Interface does not make any other warranties or representations whatsoever relating to the **Carpet Tile**, the timing of the reprocessing of the **Carpet Tile** into backing materials of new GlasBac® RE modules or the condition or quality of the new GlasBac® RE modules.
- 4. Any subsequent owner of the **Property** should notify Interface of their newly acquired ownership of the **Property**.
- 5. This Warranty shall not apply where, in the reasonable discretion of Interface:
 - (a) the Carpet Tile is heavily soiled or damaged;
 - (b) the Carpet Tile is partly or wholly burnt or in any other way transformed other than by normal wear and tear;
 - (c) the Carpet Tile is subject to platsiciser migration;
 - (d) the Carpet Tile consists of only part tiles;

- (e) the Carpet Tile is System Six® performance broadloom floorcovering;
- (f) the Carpet Tile is removed from the Property other than pursuant to this Warranty; or
- (g) Interface ceases to produce GlasBac® RE modules.
- 6. A copy of this Warranty will be forwarded to the **Architect/ Interior Designer** and **Tenant**, for their information.



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
FLOOR FINISHES PLAN


